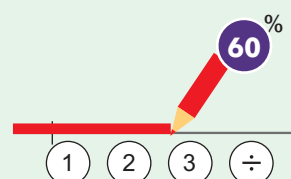

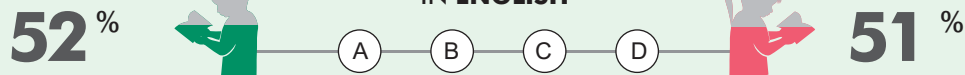

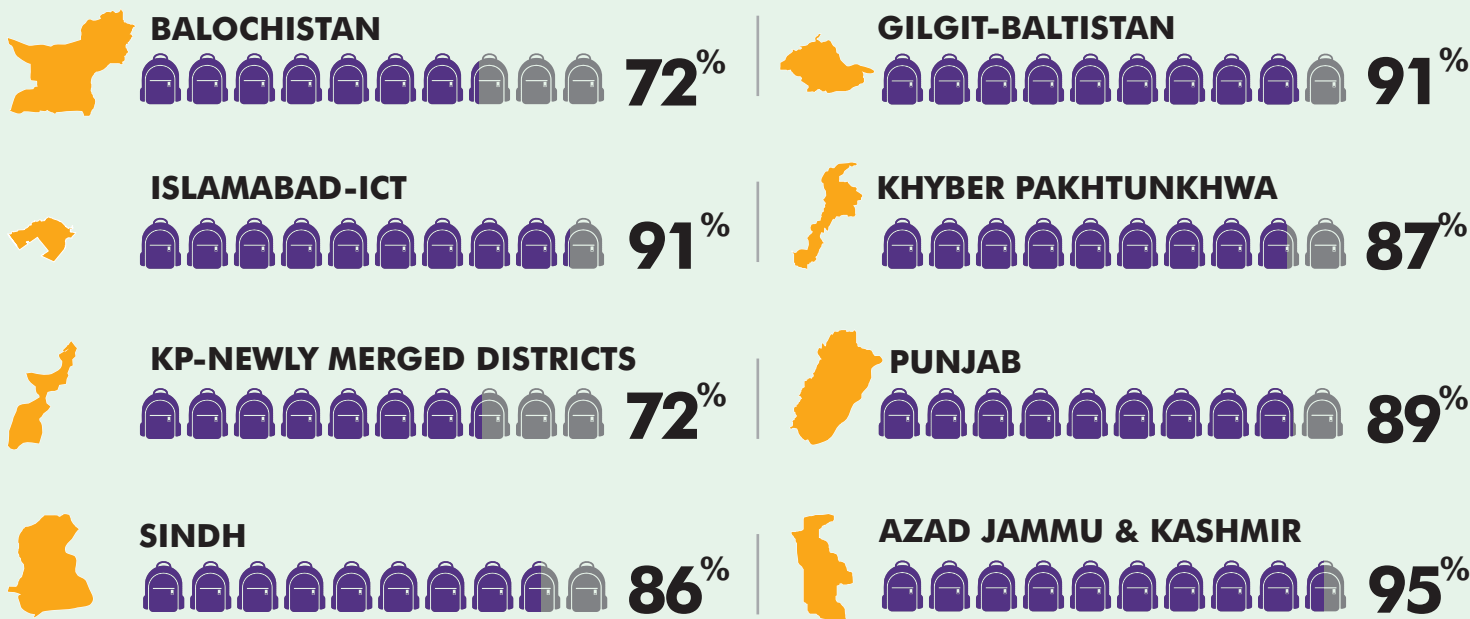

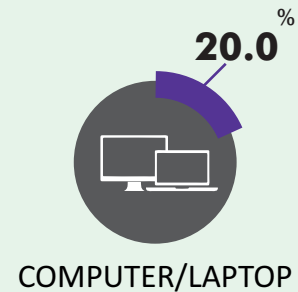
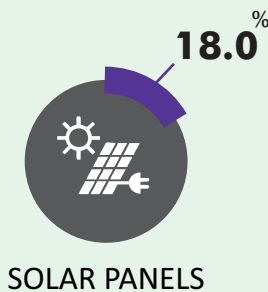
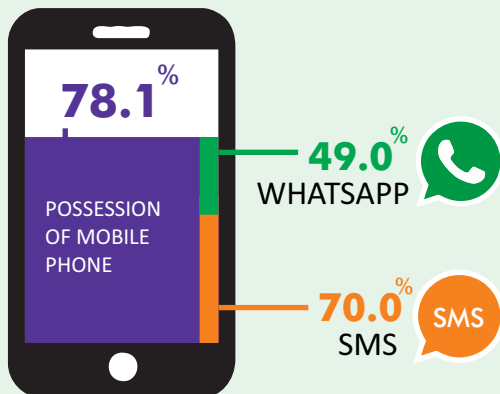
INFORMATION & COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY

- **78%** of households across all rural districts of Pakistan have mobile phones.
- Amongst mobile users, **49%** use Whatsapp service for communication.
- Amongst mobile users, **70%** use SMS facility for communication.
- **20%** of households have computers/laptops

ALTERNATE ENERGY

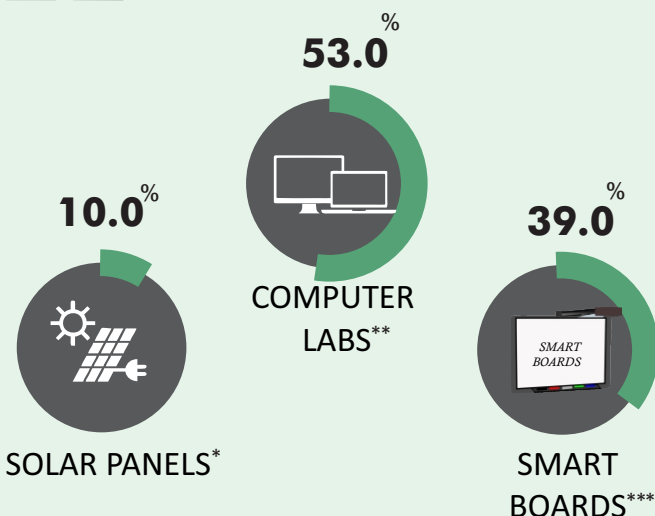
- Across all rural districts of Pakistan, **18%** of the sampled households use solar panels as an alternate energy resource.
