He served in World War II with the Queen's Own Rifles.

He was a Member of Parliament, representing Toronto-St. Paul's from 1962 until 1972.

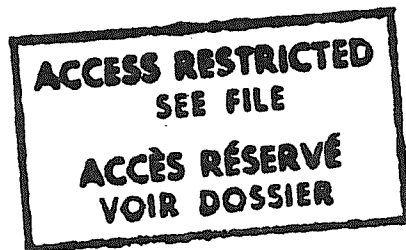
