One 15-member incident management team and 59 fireline management personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest Area.

Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel from the 302nd Airlift Wing (Air Force Reserve, CO) have been deployed to Klamath Falls, OR. Two MAFFS C-130 airtankers from the 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) and respective support personnel have been deployed to Redding, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Two hundred forty soldiers from the 1st Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Modrite fire. An Incident Management Organization (IMO) is assigned to support the military contingent.

Little Giant, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 12). Thirty miles northwest of Leavenworth, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, group torching and spotting. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grasshopper, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (CA Team 6) to CIMT (SA Team 2) will occur today. Ten miles east of Government Camp, OR. Timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, short-range spotting and uphill runs. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Austin, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Twenty-five miles southeast of Estacada, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and spotting. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wrights Spring, Fremont-Winema NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 8). Two miles west of Sprague River, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with crowning, running and spotting. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Paradise, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 6). CIMT is also managing the Hagen incident. Eighteen miles east of Milton-Freewater, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and spotting. Residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Hagen, Umatilla NF, USFS. Twenty-six miles east of Pendleton, OR. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with running, uphill runs and spotting. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Three Queens, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 13). CIMT is also managing the Grand Park 2 incident. Six miles east of Snoqualmie Pass, WA. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and short-range spotting. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Grand Park 2, Mount Rainier National Park, NPS. Seven miles southwest of Snoquera, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and grass. Moderate fire behavior with backing, single tree torching and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Big Grass, Vale District, BLM. CIMT (NW Team 10). Twenty-five miles southwest of Jordan Valley, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, short-range spotting and single tree torching. Numerous structures and critical infrastructure threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

Rowe Creek Complex (2 fires), Prineville District, BLM. CIMT (SW Team 2). Ten miles south of Fossil, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and spotting. Numerous residences and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sinlahekin, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (Cal Fire Team 4). One mile west of Tonasket, WA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, group torching and spotting. Numerous residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Bologna, Umatilla NF, USFS. CIMT (ODF Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Cottonwood incident. Seven miles northeast of Kimberly, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, flanking and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Cottonwood, John Day Unit, Oregon DOF. Fifteen miles southwest of Long Creek, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Kaiser Canyon, Colville Agency, BIA. CIMT (AK Team 2). One mile south of Nespelem, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, isolated torching and short-range spotting. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Modrite, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (NW Team 3). CIMT is also managing the Bradeen Hill and Hudspeth incidents. Seventeen miles southwest of Inchelium, WA. Timber and hardwood litter. Active fire behavior with backing, flanking and torching. Numerous residences threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

Bradeen Hill, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seventeen miles southwest of Colville, WA. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and trail closures in effect.

Hudspeth, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Three miles southeast of Hunters, WA. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

Second Flat, Burns District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 4). CIMT is also managing the Coleman Creek and Bald Mountain incidents. Six miles northeast of Riley, OR. Timber, grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Coleman Creek, Burns District, BLM. Eight miles east of Juntura, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Bald Mountain, Burns District, BLM. Fifty miles southeast of Burns, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering.

Old Trails, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (CA Team 7). CIMT is also managing the Autumn Lane and Fairview incidents. Three miles west of Spokane, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Critical infrastructure threatened.

Autumn Lane, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Seven miles northwest of Spokane, WA. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Critical infrastructure threatened.

Fairview, Northeast Region, Washington DNR. Two miles northeast of Spokane, WA. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Critical infrastructure threatened.

0587 Shingle, Fossil Unit, Oregon DOF. Transfer of command from CIMT (GB Team 5) back to the local unit will occur today. CIMT is also managing the Coyote incident. Fourteen miles southeast of Mitchell, OR. Grass and timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Coyote, Ochoco NF, USFS. Five miles south of Post, OR. Brush, timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Fox, Vale District, BLM. Twelve miles northeast of Huntington, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and single tree torching. Residences and critical infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Ptarmigan, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. NIMO (Team 3). Twenty miles northwest of Mazama, WA. Timber, medium slash and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and spotting. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wells Road, Washington State Fire Marshal's Office. Fourteen miles northeast of St. John, WA. Grass, timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences threatened.

High Lava, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. Eleven miles northwest of Stabler, WA. Timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Luna, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Ten miles north of Newhalem, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, torching and spotting. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area and trail closures in effect.

Castle, Umpqua NF, USFS. Twenty-three miles northeast of Tiller, OR. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, smoldering and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Burnt Creek, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Twenty-three miles north of Enterprise, OR. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Border 2, North Cascades National Park, NPS. Thirty-six miles northeast of Marblemount, WA. Timber. Active fire behavior with backing, flanking and running. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Prairie Mountain, Northwest Region, Washington DNR. Seven miles northeast of Darrington, WA. Heavy slash and timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Area and road closures in effect.

Eggo, Wallowa Unit, Oregon DOF. Seventeen miles northeast of Enterprise, OR. Grass and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Residences threatened.

*** Alpowa Mutual Aid**, Southeast Region, Washington DNR. Eight miles west of Clarkston, WA. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, uphill runs and flanking. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area and road closures in effect.

E Evans Creek Rd, Medford Unit, Oregon DOF. Fourteen miles northeast of Rogue River, OR. Closed timber litter, timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Communication infrastructure threatened.

Egypt, Malheur NF, USFS. Twelve miles north of Riley, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

Anthony, Wallowa-Whitman NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles north of Baker City, OR. Closed timber litter and timber. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching and creeping. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Bench, Warm Springs Agency, BIA. Four miles south of Warm Springs, OR. Timber and brush. No new information. Last narrative report unless new information is received.

Salmon, Umatilla NF, USFS. Thirty-four miles southwest of Baker City, OR. Timber and brush. No new information. Last narrative report unless new information is received.

Nunamaker Road, Spokane District, BLM. Ten miles south of Washtucna, WA. Brush and grass. No new information. Last narrative report unless new information is received.

Sand Creek, Beaverhead-Deerlodge NF, USFS. Five miles east of Wisdom, MT. Timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and group torching. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Skillset, Flathead NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 7). Fifteen miles west of Olney, MT. Timber and heavy slash. Moderate fire behavior with torching, spotting and backing. Railroad infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Elevated to locally critical fire conditions are expected across eastern New Mexico, Texas, Oklahoma, and southern Kansas due to breezy south winds gusting up to 35 mph, very hot temperatures near 105°F and RH of 10-25%. In the West, most areas will see light winds outside of thunderstorms and temperatures up to about five degrees above normal. RH will drop to 10-25% across much of the West, and 20-30% in the Greater Four Corners. Lightning with little or no wetting rain is the primary concern for central/northern California, north central/northeast Washington, the Idaho Panhandle, and southwestern/south-central Montana. Elsewhere, isolated to scattered mixed wet/dry thunderstorms are forecast from the northern Cascades into northwest Montana, and from eastern Idaho into Wyoming. A backdoor cold front will bring higher RH and scattered wetter thunderstorms east of the Divide in Montana with isolated to scattered mostly wet thunderstorms from the eastern Sierra to the West Slope, and into the Southwest. Scattered thunderstorms are expected from the Mid-Mississippi Valley to the Carolina coast and Florida. Alaska's eastern Interior remains warm and mostly dry with very isolated thunderstorms. Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands will be warmer and drier with strengthening trade winds.
